<b>Internships</b>	<p>Internships (minimum 2 months, maximum 6 months) in our research laboratories can be included in the exchange programme and combined with courses. <a href="https://www.ensat.fr/en/research/our-research-laboratories.html">https://www.ensat.fr/en/research/our-research-laboratories.html</a></p>
<b>Academic calendar</b>	<p>First semester : mid-September to End of January Second semester : February to mid-May</p>
<b>Language requirements</b>	<p>Minimum of French B1</p>
<b>French language courses</b>	<p>The INP organizes a 4-week intensive French course for incoming international students before the beginning of the university year. <a href="https://www.enseeiht.fr/fr/international/coming-to-enseeiht.html">https://www.enseeiht.fr/fr/international/coming-to-enseeiht.html</a> It includes 20 hours of French lessons per week, a preparation for engineering school studies but also cultural activities and guided tours (1 per week).</p> <p>French lessons are also proposed in each semester (3h per week) and credited (2ECTS). There are no tuition fees for exchange students.</p>
<b>Grading system</b>	<p>Our grading system is a 20-point scale. A minimum score of 10 is required to validate an Academic Unit (UE).</p> <p>0-&lt;8 = fail ≥8-10 = students can take another exam in 2nd session 10 = average (≈ GPA of 2) 12 = good (≈ GPA of 3) 14 = very good (≈ GPA of 3.7) ≥16 = excellent (≈ GPA of 4.33) 18 and above = congratulations</p>

In practice, it is not a linear scale, therefore outstanding students get a score  $\geq 15$ .  
( $\approx$  GPA of 4)

## APPLICATION FOR AN EXCHANGE

### Application procedure

All candidates must be nominated by the international office of their home University and nominations will be addressed to the ENSAT International Office ([international.ensat@toulouse-inp.fr](mailto:international.ensat@toulouse-inp.fr))

Nominated candidates will receive a link to submit their e-application on the online application mobility platform.

- ✓ Download, fill and send the learning studies form making sure that the name of the specialization or Master course is mentioned as well as the list of course modules that will be followed.

### Deadlines

**June 1<sup>st</sup>** : for 1<sup>st</sup> semester (fall semester) or full academic year

**November 1<sup>st</sup>** : for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (spring semester)

### Study requirements for incoming students

The learning agreement must contain at least **20 ECTS per semester** and in the **same engineering or Master course**. Students will need to have proven records in the prerequisites to follow the courses they wish to enrol in.

### ENSAT student's residence (CROUS)

A limited number of room is available at the ENSAT student's residence. You will be proposed to apply for within the application procedure.

### Cost of living

Accommodation :  $\approx$ 250 €/month (CROUS Residence) and as from 300 €/month (private). State housing grants to all students.

Public transport (bus, tram and metro) 11,20 € per week or 112 € per year for students <26 years of age

University restaurants:  $\approx$ 3.50 €/meal

## FORMALITIES

- Health insurance**     **A health insurance coverage is compulsory to study in France**
- For European students** : you need to request a Health Insurance European Card before your departure
- For non-European students** : you will have to register for the social security (free for all students) on AMELI website (CPAM) : <https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/> once your registration at ENSAT is completed.
- If you plan to arrive to France a few days before the beginning of the academic year, you will need a private health insurance to cover your stay in France before your registration at Ensat.**
- For all students** : a complementary health insurance (about 126€/year) is highly recommended to be reimbursed for your health care expenses at the best rate.
- Other insurances**     Civil liability insurance (compulsory) ≈ 15€/ year, payment on registration  
Insurance for the accommodation (compulsory) ≈ 25€/year
- Visa**     **EU students** : No visa required
