Engineer's

A three-year multi-disciplinary program

AgroToulouse trains engineers under student or apprentice status to become stakeholders in all the activities of the supply chain starting **from agricultural raw materials to the consumer's needs**, through the processing of agricultural products, logistics, waste treatment and more generally environmental management and sustainable development.

Students choose from 10 specialisations in final year and more than 6 specializations are offered in partnership with other institutions.
